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## This month's white wine recommendations

### **Chardonnay Guinevere Boot Hill Gusbourne 2020**

*Elegant and complex, this is a citrus driven wine with creamy and lightly toasted notes. Baked apple and pear, with some warming spices shine through. A wonderful example of a still English wine.*

**Bin 21: £90**

**Type: Full-bodied**

**Grape: Chardonnay**

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### **Qualitätswein Trocken Sybille Kuntz 2021 Mosel Germany**

*Organic wine certified; the grapes are picked in the first week of harvest. Maceration takes place in Stainless steel tanks and is fermented in acacia wood barrels. The taste is balanced and persistent between crisp green fruits, lime, floral notes, and lot of minerality with flint at the beginning.*

**Type: Dry Riesling**

**Grape: Riesling**

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### **Kin Semillon Alkina 2022 Barossa Valley Australia**

*Organic, biodynamic, and vegan wine certified. The process is two fermentations: one larger fermentation in concrete with 10% whole berries and 10% whole bunches; the second on full skins (of which 40% whole bunch) in stainless steel. The taste is balanced between Waxy and textural floral notes and exotic spice aromas.*

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### **'In der Schabau' Gruner Veltliner Ingrid Groiss 2021**

*This wine has an immense depth of flavour and an elegant feel. The nose is complex with a mixture of green apples and pear. Fresh, crunchy, and mineral-driven citrus notes aplenty, and typical white pepper finish.*

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## This month's red wine recommendations

### 'Estaladina' Mengoba 2021 Bierzo Spain

*Flavours of crushed red berries and wildflowers float across a lacy palate that strikes excellent tension between crisp acidity and light, tender tannins. It finishes with tangy-berry deliciousness and impressive persistence.*

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### 212 Carménère 'Los Lingues' Casa Silva 2021

*On the nose, it is intense, with notes of ripe black fruits and hints of wild forest fruits. On the palate, good balance between fruit and oak, good structure, powerful, sweet and round tannins, notes of berries and tobacco.*

**Bin: 212 £54**

**Type: Full-bodied**

**Grape: Carménère**

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### Monthélie Domaine Louis Jadot 2012

*A well-known winery founded in 1859. The wine is fruity with developing red fruits and cherries aromas. It is well-structured with good tannins, powerful yet still delicate.*

**Type: Medium to Full-bodied**

**Grape: Pinot Noir**

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### 157 Old Quarter Alkina Kin 2020

*Organic and biodynamic certified. Dark cherry, red liquorice, and exotic spice aromas with oak in the background. The palate is taking a distinctly savoury turn into tobacco and dusty, baked earth flavours over brooding mulberry.*

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## Private Cellar Collection

### France – Bordeaux Right and Left Bank

409 St-Estèphe Château Lafon Rochet 2016 £193

*Château Lafon-Rochet is a 4ème Cru Classé St-Estèphe estate that has been owned by the Tesseron family since 1959. The notes are rich in black pepper and tobacco, well-balanced with a lovely cassis note shining through.*

**Type: Full-bodied**                      **Grape: Blend Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc**

429 Margaux Château du Tertre 2018 £208

*Château du Tertre is a 5ème Cru Classé situated in the Margaux commune. The notes deliver a good intensity of black plums, kirsch, and black raspberry, plus hints of dried Provence herbs, tobacco leaf and cedar.*

**Type: Medium-bodied**                      **Grape: Blend Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Cabernet Franc**

429 Château Lynch Bages 2001 £622

*exhibits aromas of tapenade, bay leaf, liquorice, red and black currants, damp earth and new saddle leather. Atypically elegant and charming for a Lynch Bages with soft, fully resolved tannin and a moderately long finish.*

**Type: Medium-bodied**    **Grape: Blend 78% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc, 2% Petit Verdot**

418 St-Julien Château Léoville Barton 2007 £327

*Château Léoville Barton Is a 2eme Cru Classé. The palates reveal notes of ripe cassis, raspberry and notes of berries. The complexity develops with fine touches of tonka bean, sweet spices, and warm spices.*

**Type: Full-bodied**                      **Grape: Blend Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc**

404 St-Julien Château Ducru Beaucaillou 2016 £480

*Château Ducru Beaucaillou is one of the standout wines from this vintage. The palate gives a firm backbone cloaked in layers of black fruit. The new oak is more present.*

**Type: Full-bodied**                      **Grape: Blend Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot**

401 Margaux Château Rauzan-Segla 2010 £502

*Château Rauzan-Segla is a 2eme Cru Classé and the estate expresses the world-renowned qualities of the Margaux terroir. On the palate it expresses notes of ripe and fresh wild berries combined with touches of graphite.*

**Type: Full-bodied**                      **Grape: Blend Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot**

406 St-Emilion Château Troplong Mondot 2015 £491

*Château Troplong Mondot is a 1er Grand Cru Classé. The Chateau boasts one of the largest estates in the St-Emilion appellation. Pure and bright, the nose gives off notes of ripe fruit, cherry, blackcurrant, and spices.*

**Type: Full-bodied**                      **Grape: Blend Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc**

403 Les Forts de Latour Château Latour 2005 £664

*Les Forts de Latour is the second wine of First Growth Château Latour. The notes we can find cassis, pencil shavings, hints of tobacco. Full-bodied, with refined, silky tannins and a long finish.*

**Type: Full-bodied**                      **Grape: Blend Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc**

408 St-Estèphe Château Montrose 2001 £606

*Château Montrose is one of the leading wine properties of St-Estèphe and produces the longest-lived wines in the Médoc. The notes of the wine are blackberry, a touch of tar and pencil box, later displays of Indian ink, and cedar wood.*

**Type: Full-bodied**                      **Grape: Blend Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, and Petit Verdot**

### France – Burgundy Red

412 Nuits-St-Georges Cuvee VV Bertrand Ambroise 2011 £185

*Maison Ambroise dates to the 18th century and is certified organic since 2013. Only a few parcels had been planted around Nuits-Saint-Georges. The wine displays wonderful dark red fruit aromas, earth, and savoury tobacco notes.*

**Type: Light-bodied**

**Grape: Pinot Noir**

413 Charmes-Chambertin Grand Cru Dom. Arlaud 2016 £614

*The wine is produced from two vineyard parcels in the Mazoyères climate, it has been produced using organic methods and biodynamic techniques. Aromas of red berries, cherry, and vanilla, palate is powerful, sublime finish.*

**Type: Light-bodied**

**Grape: Pinot Noir**

417 Marsannay 'Les Grasses Têtes' Bruno Clair 2018 £182

*The wine has a deep purple robe which goes with the weight of clay, earthy barnyard nose with rustic red berries, rustic raspberry with a prickly texture, dark plum, acidity, and resinous and stemmy notes.*

### France – Burgundy White

436 Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru 'Morgeot' Thomas Morey 2019 £220

*'Morgeot' is cumulatively the largest premier cru vineyard in Chassagne-Montrachet. The palate is aromatic, and it reveals notes of Blossom, honey, passion fruit, apple, floral, toast and lemon peel making the wine complex and buttery.*

**Type: Medium to full-bodied**

**Grape: Chardonnay**

436B Chassagne-Montrachet Simon Colin 2019 £186

*A very pretty, delicate nose of juicy apricot and clementine. A light floury taste with hints of cream, fresh butter, and elderflower. Generous orange and clementine flesh on the palate. A Nice minerality and a medium floral finish.*

**Type: Medium to full-bodied**

**Grape: Chardonnay**

435 Puligny-Montrachet 'Les Combette' Etienne Sauzet 2017 £159

*The world's greatest dry white wines are produced in this area of Burgundy. The estate has been biodynamic since 2010. Les 'Combettes' 1er Cru has a fresh bouquet with notes of mandarin oil, pear, peach, and fresh bread.*

**Type: Medium to full-bodied**

**Grape: Chardonnay**

435 Puligny-Montrachet Etienne Sauzet 2019 £240

*The estate and produced biodynamically since 2010. It exhibits aromas of crisp white peach, orange oil, spring blossom and freshly baked bread.*

433 Meursault 1er Cru 'Perriere' Balot-Millot 2018 £640

*'Perrières' is a Premier cru at the southern end of Meursault. The palate has a flinty texture and great minerality It is fully expressed after opening, straightforward mid-palate with a well-rounded finish.*

**Grape: Chardonnay**

434 Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru 'Champs gains' Paul Pillot 2019 £480

*'Les Champs-Gains' is a creamy wine from Côte de Beaune. It aged for at least 12 months in oak barrels. Aromas of white flowers, crisp green apples, beeswax, and fresh bread.*

434 Cornas Domaine du Tunnel 2015 £162

*The bouquet includes dark berries, liquorice, leather, minerals, chocolate, On the palate, it has spices, beautiful and juicy acidity with tannin, notes of old rose, cherry, and raspberry, black cherry, toast, and cocoa bean.*

419 Octavius Amarone Della Valpolicella Riserva Fumanelli 2015 £235

*A limited-edition wine, the grapes are left to dry for 120 days to concentrate the flavours, then aged in French oak barrels for 2 years. Powerful yet elegant with wild cherry, sweet vanilla, nutmeg, mocha.*

**Grape: Blend of Corvina, Corvinone and Rondinella**

420 Ornellaia, Tenuta dell 'Ornellaia 2018 £570

*Pure, rich and seductive with a smoky character. A wine which is structured yet soft, powerful but finessed. Full of flavour with notes of leather, vanilla bean, raspberry and red cherry.*

**Grape: Blend Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Cabernet Franc**

421 La Grazia, Tenuta dell 'Ornellaia Limited edition 2018 £600

*Nestled in the foothills near Bolgheri, Ornellaia lies in a unique position, a few kilometres inland from the Mediterranean, whose cool sea breezes provide a moderating effect. The estate has become synonymous with Super Tuscan wine. A wine styled with finesse, notes of sweet berries, mocha and dried flowers.*

417 Corbaia Castello di Bossi 2012 £201

425 Gran Arzuaga Bodega Arzuaga 2015 £467

*This wine of iconic status is only made in selective years when the quality is thought to be on another level. Complex, with primary aromas of red fruit, herbaceous and floral scents make the wine silky and creamy in the mouth.*

### Australia

431 Giaconda Estate Shiraz 2019 £201

*Giaconda Vineyard and Winery is in Victoria's Beechworth. The wine has notes of damp forest floor combine with campfire smoke, raspberry, and star anise, with a satisfying fruit-laden palate of wild berries coming to the fore.*
